
Setting up Email on MAC:

Step 1: If this is your First Time Setting up Outlook for Mac on your Computer You will see the screen below.

Follow the on screen prompts and click continue if this is not your first time continue to step 4



Step 2: Keep Office for Mac up To Date: Select Yes Join the Customer Experience Improvement Program: No




Step 3: Tick Make Outlook the Default Application for e-mail, calendar and contacts Click **Add Account**


Step 5: Click Exchange Account




Step 6: E-mail address: Enter your Email Address


